Jerry Moe is the National Director of the Hazelden Betty Ford Children's Program, an Advisory Board Member of the National Association for Children of Alcoholics (NACoA), he is an author, lecturer, and trainer on issues for children and families hurt by addiction. In 2013 he received the Mona Manswell Award and the Father Joseph C. Martin Award.

Moe's latest book is *Through a Child's Eyes: Understanding Addiction and Recovery*. He received the 2005 America Honors Recovery Award from the Johnson Institute and the 2000 Ackerman/Black Award from the NACoA for "significantly improving the lives of children of alcoholics in the United States and around the world".

Children have a unique perspective in viewing the world. While it's long been held that alcoholism and drug addiction are a family disease, there are relatively few opportunities for children to be an integral part of the healing process. More importantly, learn specific strategies, and effective tools and techniques which can make a real difference in their lives. There is much hope today for these kids.
